



Careers in manufacturing: recreational vehicles

Service and repair

Recreational vehicle service and repair people are employed in workshops servicing and repairing recreational vehicles, including motor homes, caravans, camper trailers, slide-ons and fifth wheelers. They may work in a service and repair facility or a manufacturer's factory undertaking warranty work.

Those working as a service and repairer would be expected to work under supervision servicing and repairing recreational vehicles.

Responsibilities may include:

- carrying out insurance repairs
- carrying out other repairs
- working under warranty
- undertaking modifications/refits to the recreational vehicle
- undertaking routine servicing
- preparing a recreational vehicle for sale/resale.

Relevant qualifications:

- Certificate II in Recreational Vehicle Service and Repair
- Certificate III in Recreational Vehicle Service and Repair
